Financial Information

Pacific Adventist University is owned and operated by the Seventh-day Adventist (SDA) Church. The SDA Church makes a significant financial contribution towards the operation of the university each year.

Students who are self sponsored, may be eligible for a free subsidy.

This subsidy is available to individual students at the discretion of the University Administration. While the university has every intention of maintaining the subsidy program long term, the subsidy may be withdrawn at any time for a number of reasons, including increasing costs or where students fail to abide by the code of ethics outlined in the student handbook.

The level of SDA Church subsidy differs based on the program of study.

- 45% for School of Business and School of Science and Technology degrees
- 55% for School of Humanities, Education and Theology, and School of Health Science (SoHET) degrees
- 72% for SoHET Bachelor of Arts in Theology

It is important to note that the subsidy only applies to tuition and practicum fees, not residential, transport or miscellaneous fees.

Costs provided here were accurate at the time of printing, but are subject to change from year to year (current fees information should be sought from PAU at the time of enquiry or from the PAU website www.pau.ac.pg).

Confirmation of fees for any year will be available by October of the previous year.

75% of fees must be paid at least 2 weeks before registration.

Payment Options

There are 2 options available for the payment of fees:

1. An upfront payment of the full semester's fee prior to registration (usually by the end of the third week of January). A rebate of 5% will be given with this option.
2. Payment of 75% of the full semester's fee prior to registration (usually by the end of the third week of January); the balance of 25% must be paid in full a month before semester examinations.

Please note that accommodation will not be made available if the above payment are not met.

For PAU to recognise your payment, you must make sure that the bank records on the deposit entry description the name of the student whose fees you are paying.

2. Bank Cheque
3. EFTPOS payment at PAU Cashier

Notes:

- You will need to provide evidence of payment of fees prior to confirming travel arrangements to PAU.
- School fee refunds will only be given at withdrawal and upon graduating, not at any time of the year.
- All continuing students must clear 100% of outstanding fees, as well as 75% of their fees for the following year prior to registration.

Additional Notes

1. All new/first year students are required to attend orientation. Additional accommodation fees to be borne by student.
2. Undergraduate approximate tuition costs above are based on five subjects per semester. However, cost may vary depending on the number of subjects taken within a semester.
3. First and second year Business students are not

required to do practicum, therefore, the practicum fees do not apply in those years.

4. Graduation fee - for final year students only inclusive of cap and gown hire.
5. Housing bond (married students) payment in cash is required by all new students who rent married student accommodation. A house inspection is required at the commencement and conclusion of the tenancy, as well as twice a year, and the bond maybe used to cover full or part of the costs of damage incurred during the tenancy. The bond less cost of any repairs will be reimbursed only after the house is inspected and keys returned to the Director of Student Services. Gas and electricity expenses are to be paid by renters in addition to the house rental. Excessive use of water may also incur additional costs.
6. Key deposit (includes key and breakage fee) single students. Fee will be reimbursed when key is returned to the Director of Student Services at the end of study. Students who hold keys for a house or dormitory room at the university outside the academic semester are charged rent or board whether they are on campus or not.
7. Married students must gain university permission for a live-in baby sitter and must pay the additional fee before registration by approved students already enrolled in the university.
8. Boarding accommodation will be given only to those who make prior payment of the 75% of the fees.
9. Late registration fee is for students who arrive later or do not register within the prescribed registration period advertised by the university. Students who do not register within two week must leave the campus.
10. Students with outstanding fees will not be able to register for subsequent semesters.
11. Students with outstanding fees must settle all outstanding fees by Tuesday prior to graduation. Failure to do so will result in not being able to participate in the year's graduation service.

Sponsorship

1. PNG Tertiary Education Study Assistance Scheme (TESAS) scholarships are available in two categories to PNG citizens. These are administered by the Office of Higher Education (OHE) and either information may be obtained from the OHE.
 - **Academic Excellence Scholarship (AES) Category** is available to students who are in the top 5% of the institutions academic performance (achieving a semester GPA of 3.6 or more in both semesters). TESAS-AES meets K5,760 of the fees and the students meet the difference.
 - **Higher Education Contribution Assistance Scheme (HECAS) Category** sponsored students are in the next 48% of the institution's academic performance, or having a semester GPA of 2.0 to 3.5. TESAS-HECAS meets K4,320 of the fees and the students meets the difference.
2. Overseas governments and agencies (for example AusAID or Solomon Islands Government) offer full scholarships for academically suitable applicants. Contact government scholarship offices for further details.
3. Pacific Adventist University Work Scholarship Scheme (PAU WSS) is offered to a small number of students on the basis of academic merit, overall favourable behaviour and financial need. Up to 90% of the cost of tuition and board may be rewarded. This scheme is applicable only to enrolled students (it is not available for first year of study).
